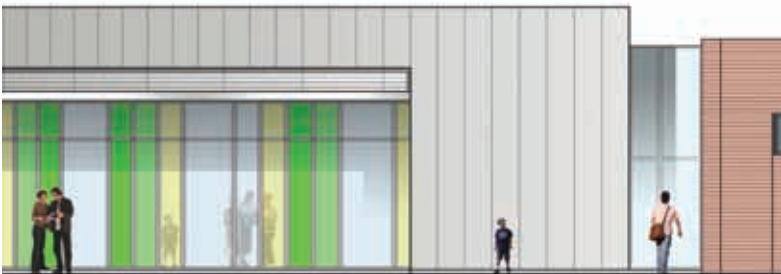

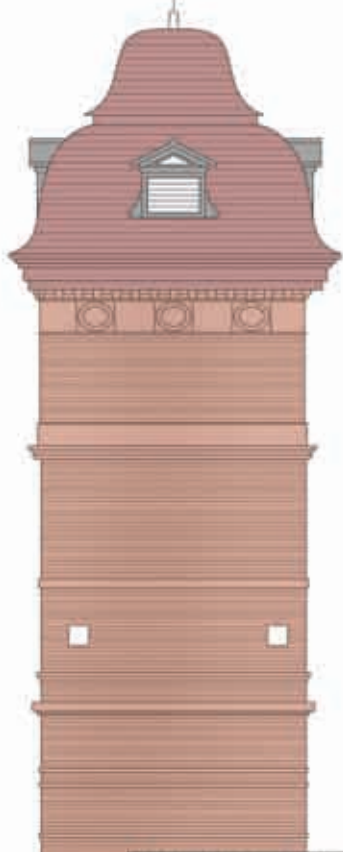

A green roof to improve insulation, reduce flash flooding from storms and improve the lifespan of the roof.

Solar roof panels using the sun's power to heat water.

Photo-voltaic cells on the roof to generate electricity from the sun.

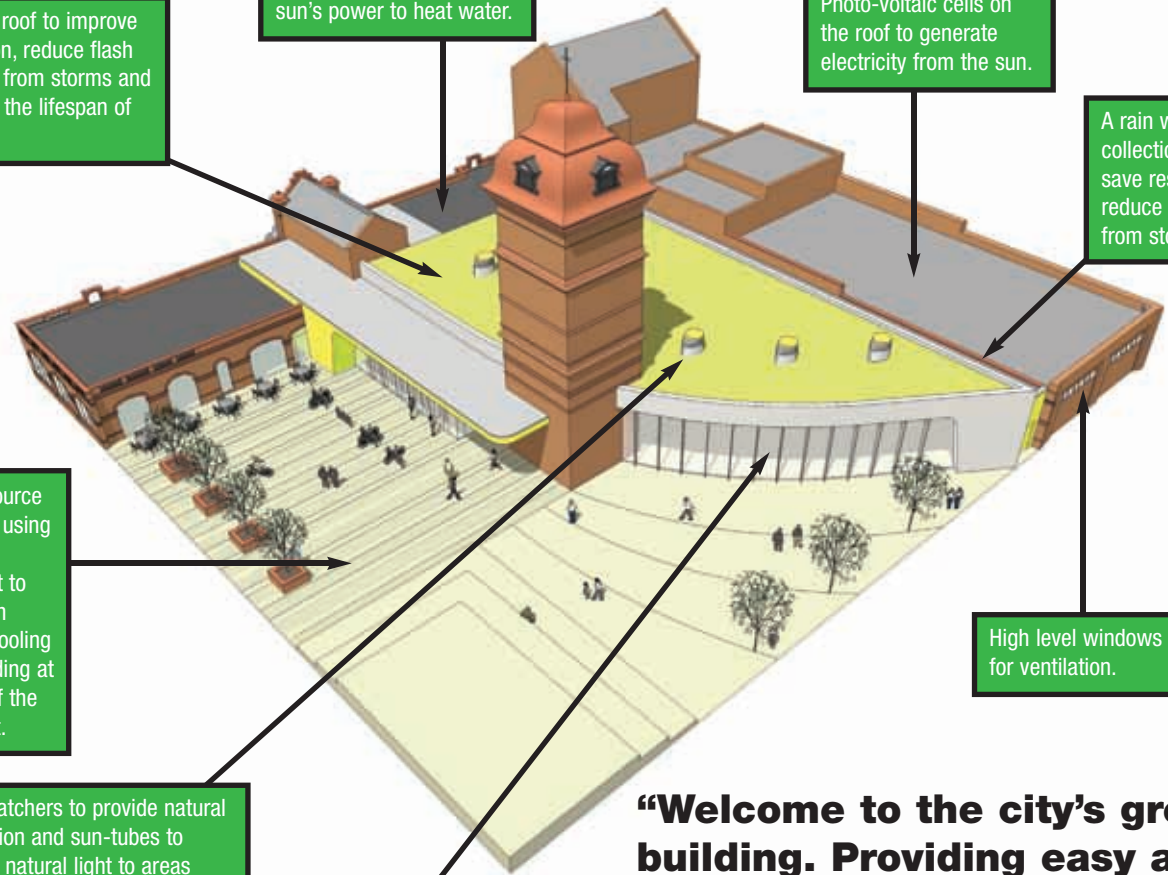
A rain water collection system to save resources and reduce flash flooding from storms.

A ground source heat pump, using the earth's natural heat to provide both heating & cooling for the building at a fraction of the normal cost.

Wind-catchers to provide natural ventilation and sun-tubes to provide natural light to areas away from the windows.

Double glazed windows, including coloured glass, to help maintain a comfortable building temperature all year round and to diffuse the light to prevent glare.

High level windows and grilles for ventilation.
