

Introduction to Inspiring learning for all

The introductory, morning ILFA session will enable participants to:

- explore previous experiences of ILFA through group discussion
- explore existing ideas about learning, learning organisations and evaluation through group discussion
- get an abridged history behind the core concepts behind ILFA
- get an introduction to the ILFA framework and how it can be used
- get an introduction to the GLOs and GSOs
- practice coding outcomes using the language of GLOs and GSOs
- apply the explored theory through short case studies from MLA funded projects

Inspiring Learning for all and insight-guided practice

The afternoon session will enable participants to:

- get a refresher/ summary of what has been explored in the introductory session
- explore the role of evaluation in a learning organisation
- explore discussed theory through MLA funded case studies
- formulate desired GLOs or GSOs for their audiences or staff through group discussion
- formulate an action plan relating to desired GLOs or GSOs through group discussion
- formulate an evaluation plan relating to desired GLOs or GSOs through group discussion

Both sessions will include breaks, which lend themselves to networking, and handouts will be available to take away.
